Even if your get locked out of your mailbox, if the mail server is down, even if there are issues with the Internet connection you will still be able to access last seven (7) days of email via friendly and secure web interface.

<u>Custom Domain Signatures</u> - One of the most demanded features has been providing consistent corporate identity on outgoing email. ExchangeDefender now supports custom message signatures, both plain text and rich text / HTML.
